## Gentlemen:

By letter dated October 15, 1992 PECO Energy Company submitted Technical Specifications (TS) Change Request No. 92-03-0 for Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2, requesting changes to the LGS TS surveillance intervals to facilitate a change in LGS refueling cycles from 18 months to 24 months.

Since this request was submitted, the NRC has approved and issued LGS, Unit 1 and Unit 2, licensing amendments that resulted in changes to several TS pages which were contained in the October 15, 1992 submittal. PECO Energy re-submitted the TS pages which were affected by subsequent amendments by letter dated April 29, 1994. Inadvertently, Unit 1 and Unit 2 TS page 3/4 6-14 was re-submitted on April 29, 1994, without all the proposed 24 month changes identified within the October 15, 1992 submittal.

Attachment 1 to this letter contains the revised Unit 1 and Unit 2 TS page 3/4 6-14 for Change Request No. 92-03-0 and supersedes all previous submittals affecting this page. This information is being submitted under affirmation, and the required affidavit is enclosed.
