 - b) records of the licensee show that no more than the maximum amount of radioactivity per source specified in Item 8 of the license was ordered from the supplier or transferor for the radioactive material;
- c) The levels of radiation from radiography exposure device and storage containers do not exceed those specified in Arizona Administrative Code R12-1-505.A.
- 15. In addition to the radioactive material authorized in Items 6, 7 and 8 above, the licensee is authorized to possess, use, transfer and import up to 999 kilograms of uranium contained as shielding material in the radiography exposure devices and source changers authorized by this license.
- 16. The licensee shall perform leak testing of sealed sources containing radioactive material in accordance with A.A.C. R12-1-429.
- 17. The licensee is authorized to collect leak-test samples in accordance with application dated July 24, 1989.
- 18. Sealed sources of radioactive material shall not be combined for use in open air techniques to produce a radiation level in excess of the level produced by the largest single source authorized by this license for open air use.


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
