NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Southwestern Medical Center

During an NRC inspection conducted on November 27, 1990, a violation of NRC requirements was identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1990), the violation is listed below:

10 CFR 35.27(a) requires, in part, that a licensee may permit any visiting authorized user to use licensed material for medical use under the terms of the licensee's license for 60 days each year if the visiting authorized user has the prior written permission of the institution's radiation safety committee and the licensee's management, and in addition, the licensee has a copy of a license issued by the NRC or an Agreement State that identifies the visiting authorized user for medical use.

Contrary to the above, a visiting authorized user used licensed material under the terms of the licensee's license between August 22, 1989, and November 27, 1990, without the prior written permission of the institution's management and the radiation safety committee.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Southwestern Medical Center, is hereby required to submit to this office, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation if admitted, (2) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, (3) the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations, and (4) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
