This license authorizes the export of 750.00 short tonnes (680,581.0 kilograms) of nuclear grade graphite. The license is amended to extend the expiration date from 07 May 1994 to 21 April 1996. The following conditions apply:

(1) Individual pieces of graphite may not weigh more than 200.0 kilograms; (2) Individual shipments may not exceed 3,000.0 kilograms; (3) No more than 30 metric tonnes per year may be exported to any one recipient country except to the Nether ands. Shipment for storage at Poco Graphite's warehouse in the Netherlands prior to onward distribution to ultimate consignees in the countries lister above is not restricted; and (4) Re-exports to ASEAN countries i.e., Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines and Thailand, permitted under Singapore IDVC be limited to: (a) articles manufactured f non-nuclear end uses, or (b) general license quantities if bulk block or rod form.
