MOTION TO EXPAND ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

- 1. In its Order Imposing Civil Monetary Penalty, NRC staff limited issues for consideration at any hearing protesting the penalty, to two issues only.
- 2. Nevertheless Judge Ivan W. Smith has allowed the issue of personal malice by certain NRC staff to be a legitimate factor for consideration at such a hearing.
- 3. In the interest of serving justice in this matter and the overall national good, Licensee proposes that the Board further allow consideration whether NRC staff in its actions after Dec.11, 1992 effectively and with malice denied due process rights to Licensee.
- 4. Since accountability for actions by public officials is at the heart of our form of government, Licensee requests this motion be granted given the gravity of the issue.
