In response to your request of December 2, 1982 concerning NRC Generic Letter 81-10, CPSES provides the following information:

- 1. The CPSES Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) is located 1.2 miles west of the power plant.
- The EOF is constructed of concrete and the protection factor has been upgraded to >15.
- The HVAC in the EOF can be manually isolated providing a positive pressurization and HEPA filtration of any makeup air.
- Construction of the EOF began September 1981.
   Construction was completed August 1982.
- Equipment is currently being installed in the EOF and will be in place prior to fuel load.
- 6. An alternate EOF is not planned due to the upgraded protection factor rating of the EOF.
