FOR A PROMPT NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

Region IV reports indicate that Arkansas Nuclear One Units 132, Fort Calhoun and Cooper have installed and tested their prompt notification systems. Presently, Ft. St. Vrain reports that they have delivered approximately 95% of their elert redios, conducted a radio reception test in their 5 mile EFE. and verified reception at each installation (reception test when delivered). I am sending an inspector to Ft. St. Yrain on February 2, 1982, unannounced, to verify their status.

Unless Public Service of Colorado is incorrect in their status report. I conclude that all of the licensees in Region IV are in compliance with the February 1, 1982 deadline for implementation.
