Dear Mr. Lundvall:

By your application and affidavit dated September 22, 1902 you submitted a report describing the inspection of guide tube wear at Calvert Cliffs Unit 1. This report is entitled, "Results of Eddy Current Testing on Guide Tubes at Calvert Cliffs Unit 1 after Cycle 5", CEN-216 (B)-P, August, 1982.

Your reasons for requesting our withholding of this information were related to the protection of Combustion Engineering's competitive position concerning test data on CE fuel.

We have reviewed your application and material based on the requirements and criteria of 10 CFR 2.790 and have determined that the above-mentioned document sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information.

We also have found at this time that the right of the public to be fully apprised as to the bases for and effects of the proposed action does not outweigh the demonstrated concern for protection of your competitive position. Accordingly, we have determined that the information should be withheld from public disclosure.

We therefore approve your request for withholding the above-referenced material concerning test data on CE fuel.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the document. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course assure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary data.
