

Dear Mr. Moore:

Please consider this letter as a request to amend our Import License number ISNM 82002 to include the additional quantities as stated below:

- 4) This is enriched uranium acquired by Reaktor Brennelement Union, GmbH Federal Republic of Germany, through a trade agreement with Kernkraft-werk Kruemmel, GmbH, F.R.G. This trade was agreed by full knowledge of Euratom Supply Agency and now has the Euratom contract number AG-1670 Code A. Origin of material is U.S.
- 5) The material will be used as feed material for high enriched uranium for European MTR-Testing reactors. The UF6 will be loaded in Type B packages, according to I.A.E.A. USA/4909/B()F, rev. 3, and shipped to U.S.D.O.E. for a credit of the European Usage Agreement Number 3075.
- 6) The additional quantities which we are requesting are as follows:

1593.607 Kgs U 46.871 Kgs U-235 3.088 pct. U-235

7) This material will be imported by Sea shipment and will be delivered to U.S.D.O.E. c/o Union Carbide Corp., Oak Ridge, Tennessee, or Goodyear Atomic Corp., Piketon, Ohio by truck.
