Grimsley's response dated March 21, 1990. Mr. Grimsley's response denied records subject to Ms. Garde's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for copies of all records related to Inspection Report numbers 50-445/90-05 and 50-446/90-05 and NRC's inspection into the Therm-A-Lag issues that were subject to this inspection report regarding the Comanche Peak plant. You specifically appealed the denial of the records identified on Appendix C of Mr. Grimsley's response dated March 28, 1990. Acting on your appeal, I have carefully reviewed the record in this case and have determined that since a proposed civil penalty was issued on May 17, 1990, certain records can now be made publicly available. Your appeal is, therefore, partially granted and partially denied. The records identified on the enclosed Appendix A can now be made publicly available and are enclosed. The disclosable portions of the records identified on the enclosed Appendix B are also enclosed. The records identified on the enclosed Appendix C are already available for public inspection and copying in the NRC Public Document Room, 2120 L Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. The remaining portions of the records identified on the enclosed Appendix B will continue to be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemptions (5), (6), and (7)(C) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5), (6), and (7)(C)) and 10 CFR 9.17(a)(5), (6), and (7)(iii) of the Commission's regulations. The predecisional handwritten notes that continue to be withheld pursuant to Exemption (5) consist of candid opinions or the staff. Release of this information would tend to inhibit the open and frank expression of ideas essential to the internal deliberative process. The information withheld pursuant to Exemptions (6) and (7)(C) consists of the names of individuals whose employment was terminated and other names and personal information the disclosure of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. I find that there are overriding privacy and public interests in protecting this information. The interest in disclosing the information does not outweigh the significant privacy interests of the individuals who, if their identities were disclosed, could reasonably be expected to be subjected to harassment or other harm.

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This is a final agency decision. As set forth in the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(B)), judicial review of this decision is available in a district court of the United States in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business or in the District of Columbia.
