Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. R. E. Burgin of this office on November 9, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 48-17740-01 and to the discussion of our findings with you, Ms. J. Behrens, and Messrs. M. Decorha and L. Johnson at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated November 16, 1979, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our October 1979 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as described in the enclosed Appendix. The inspection showed that action had been taken to correct the identified noncompliance and to prevent recurrence. Consequently, no reply to this noncompliance is required and we have no further questions regarding this matter at this time.

We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
