Reichhold of this office on November 29, 1990, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 34-24871-01 and to the telephone conversation concerning our findings with you on December 28, 1990. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel. In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated March 7, 1990, regarding apparent violations found during our December 1989 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters. During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required. During the inspection, it was noted that the caution radioactive materials labels on some of the exposure devices (cameras #26 and #32) and the "Yellow II" labels on a shipping overpack were worn. We recommend that you replace worn labels before they become illegible. We will review this matter during the next inspection. In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter, the closures, and your response to this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room. The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget a. required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
