Deans, Dr. R. H. Christenson, and Messrs. J. Behm, R. Yoss and M. Wojciechowski at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated January 23, 1980, regarding apparent items of non-compliance found during our November 1979 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, no items of noncompliance were identified for License No. 48-03280-02; however, for License No. 48-03280-01, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.
