We have completed our review of Revision 18 to your Corporate Emergency Management Plan (CEMP-100). Based on our review, we have concluded that the changes meet the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50 with one exception.

On page 50 of 59, Section 7.3, "Maintenance and Inventory of Emergency Equipment and Supplies," the inventory frequency was changed from "at approximately six months" to "at regular intervals." The inventory list, frequency, and location of equipment is not defined in the paragraph. This matter was discussed with Mr. Mark Counts of South Carolina Electric and Gas Company. The licensee representative committed to revise the paragraph to reference EPP-019 and EPP-022 of the Site Emergency Plan. These procedures specify the inventory frequency, locations, and inventory lists for emergency equipment that are to be performed per Section 7.3 of CEMP-100. The licensee committed to complete the aforementioned changes during the next Plan review cycle.

Please be reminded that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires that proposed changes that decrease the effectiveness of your Emergency Plan shall not be implemented without application to and approval by the Commission. However, changes may be made without Commission approval if such changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the Plan, and the Plan, as changed, continues to meet the standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b) and the requirements of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50. If a change is made without approval, you should furnish copies in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Also, any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section V.
