This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. E. Puska at the conclusion of the inspection. This also refers to your letter dated October 18, 1982, containing additional information and the telephone discussion between Mr. E. Puska and Ms. E. Matson on November 23, 1982.


The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.

The responses directed by this letter (and the accompanying Notice) are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
