SUBJECT: NRC Security Inspection - Trojan

This letter refers to an unannounced routine Safeguards Inspection conducted by Mr. D. Schaefer of this office on December 10-14, 1990. The inspection included a review of your activities at Trojan Nuclear Plant. On December 14, 1990, at the conclusions of the site visit, the preliminary inspection findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report. Further, this letter refers to a telephone discussion between Messrs. A. Ankrum, PGE, and D. Schaefer of this office on January 2, 1991.

Areas examined during this inspection included activities related to physical protection as described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with facility and contract personnel, and observations of activities in progress.

Within the scope of the inspection, one licensee-identified apparent violation was reviewed concerning inadequate background screening investigation for an employee granted unescorted site access. This apparent violation is not being cited because the criteria specified in NRC's Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, Part V.G.1, were satisfied.

In accordance with Section 2.790(d) of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, documentation of the findings of your safeguards and security procedures are exempt from public disclosure; therefore, the enclosed report will not be placed in the NRC Public Document Room, and will receive limited distribution.

We have determined that the enclosure to this letter contains Safeguards Information and must be protected against unauthorized disclosure in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 73.21.
