Dear Congressman Hastert:

Your letter of October 17, 1990, requested a number of Commission documents pertaining to the Commission's recent decision amending its agreement with the State of Illinois.

I appreciate the assistance that your Administrative Assistant Scott Palmer has provided in clarifying the scope of your request and working with us to protect the sensitive adjudicatory advice and opinion contained in SECY-90-254 and associated documents including a September 13, 1990 response memorandum to Commissioner Curtiss, prepared by our General Counsel; as well as the Commissioners' vote sheets. As agreed to by our respective staffs, those documents are not being provided at this time.

I am enclosing the Commissioners' vote sheets on SECY-90-253, "Proposed Amendment Number One to the Agreement Between the State of Illinois and U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission Pursuant to Section 274 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, As Amended." Also enclosed are memoranda pertaining to SECY-90-253 written by the Commissioners to the staff and the staff's responses with the exception of the September 13 General Counsel memorandum described above. Finally, I have enclosed the "Staff Requirements" memoranda that represents the closeout actions for both SECY-90-253 and SECY-90-254. I would ask that you restrict access to the vote sheets of Chairman Carr and Commissioner Remick to your personal staff since they have not been released to the public. The remainder of the documents, including SECY-90-253 which you received previously, are not similarly restricted and may be released.

After discussions with your staff, I believe that the enclosed documents will satisfy your request. Again, thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
