Your letter dated December 3, 1990, indicated your inability to attend the December 12, 1990, Alternate Concentration Limit (ACL) workshop in Bethesda, Maryland. I am enclosing a set of the view-graphics which were used during the meeting for your information.

As you can see from these handouts, there has been no significant change in ACL philosophy or requirements since the October 1988 seminar held in Denver or ACL methodology for Title II licensees. Since a number of Title II licensee's representatives attended this recent workshop, some of whom questioned the need for a follow-on workshop, a representative of the American Mining Congress has volunteered to aid us in assessing the need for an additional seminar.

When the final summary for the recent Title I meeting is available, we intend to distribute it to all of our licensees who potentially will be considering ACL applications.
