SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-344/94-03

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. H. Dean Chaney of this office on May 23-26, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Trojan Nuclear Plant facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with Mr. S. Quennoz and those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Your activities associated with staff training, spent fuel storage, and radiation protection were evaluated. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

Your analytical ability for evaluating environmental monitoring samples for radioactivity was found to be in violation of the requirements in your Offsi e Dose Calculation Manual for Trojan Nuclear Plant. This violation is not being cited because the criteria in paragraph VII.B.2 of Appendix C to 10 CFR Part 2 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," were satisfied. This is considered an isolated occurrence and is not indicative of a programmatic breakdown in your environmental monitoring program. We also note that your staff took prompt and effective actions to correct the problem and prevent a future recurrence.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
