NOTICE OF AUTHORIZATION OF OPERATION ABOVE 50 PERCENT POWER

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) has authorized the Commonwealth Edison Company (licensee) to proceed above 50% power for operation of the La Salle County Station, Unit No. 1 (facility) located in Brookfield Township, La Salle County, Illinois. This authorization is effective as of the date of issuance.

License Condition 2.C(33)(b) of the La Salle County Station, Unit 1 License
No. NPF-11 required the licensee to perform an independent review of the heating,
ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems acceptable to the NRC staff
prior to exceeding 50% power. An Independent HVAC Review Final Report Project,
6356-N, dated October 27, 1982 was received from the independent reviewer, C. F.
Braun & Company, and reviewed by the staff. The NRC staff found the report
acceptable and therefore, the license condition was satisfied. On December 3, 1982
the NRC authorized the licensee to proceed above 50% power at the facility.
