EXERCISE OF ENFORCEMENT DISCRETION

This is to inform the Commission that, in a Notice of Violation being issued on or about July 1, 1994 to Baltimore Gas and Electric Company concerning violations identified in the plant security program, there is reference to a violation of a plant Technical Specification (TS) for which the staff has determined that it would be appropriate to exercise enforcement discretion and not issue an enforcement action. The violation of the plant TS involved the removal of a missile barrier door for 15 days in the emergency diesel generator room without declaring all three emergency diesel generators inoperable. In accordance with section VII.B.(6) of the Enforcement Policy, the staff is hereby notifying the Commission of its determination to exercise enforcement discretion with respect to that violation.

It should be noted that the licensee has not been specifically informed of the enforcement action. The schedule of issuance and notification is:
