12 SECRETARY CHILK: Mr. Chairman, the item is
13 SECY-91-27. It's a Motion for Reconsideration of CLI-90-
14 08.

15 The Commission is being asked here to
16 reconsider its October 17, 1990 order which was published
17 in the Commission Licensing Issuances 90-08, which denied
18 a request to publish an environmental impact statement
19 considering "resumed operation" as an alternative to the
20 decommissioning of the Shoreham facility.

21 All Commissioners have approved an order, which
22 is attached to our memorandum of February 21st, which
23 denies a motion for reconsideration because petitioners
24 have failed to demonstrate any legal flaw in CLI-90-08.
25 The order also provides guidance to the parties regarding

1 potential requests for NRC action to order operation of
2 Shoreham under Sections 108, 186(c), or 188 of the Atomic
3 Energy Act.

4 Would you please affirm your votes?

5 CHAIRMAN CARR: Aye.

6 COMMISSIONER ROGERS: Aye.

7 COMMISSIONER CURTISS: Aye.

8 COMMISSIONER REMICK: Aye.

9 CHAIRMAN CARR: Is there anything else to come
