The Commission has requested the Office of the Federal Register to publish the enclosed "Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License" for the Rancho Seco Nuclear Generating Station. This notice relates to your license amendment application dated September 28, 1982, which would permit the expansion of the spent fuel storage capacity.

This expansion would be accomplished by replacing the existing spent fuel storage racks consisting of 579 storage locations, including three failed fuel container locations, with new high density poisoned storage racks consisting of 1080 storage locations, including four failed fuel container locations.
