SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT NO. 50-341/94008(DRS)

This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Training inspection conducted by M. J. Jordan, and other NRC members on June 13 - 17, 1994. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Fermi facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

The one area of concern identified involved the inconsistent implementation of simulator training between operations and staff crews. Because of the difference in their training, the response to an event in the control room may be different from the staff crew licensee than an operating crew licensee. No written response to this item is required by this report. This information is being provided for evaluation by your Systems Approach to Training program.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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
