SUBJECT: DEMAND FOR INFORMATION LETTER DATED NOVEMBER 2, 1990 AND  
YOUR RESPONSE DATED NOVEMBER 14, 1990

We have reviewed your response dated November 14, 1990 and your License No. 12-11286-01, and determined that you will need to amend your license in order to maintain compliance with 10 CFR Part 30.35, "Financial Assurance and Recordkeeping for Decommissioning".

Your current license does not specify an overall possession limit for the total amount of material you may possess. Consequently, you will need to amend your license to include total possession limits for the sealed sources listed on your license, which are below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d) in order to maintain compliance. As an alternative, you may submit financial assurance of \$75,000 and maintain the current (no overall possession limit) status of your license.

Please be advised that implementation of the regulation occurs when possession limit thresholds are met, not by the storage or transportation status of material.

The NRC considers violation of this requirement to be a significant regulatory concern. Therefore, in order for the NRC to determine whether your license should be modified, suspended or revoked, or other enforcement action taken to ensure compliance with NRC regulatory requirements, you are required to respond within 30 days.
