Findings and Determination

Under Section 302(c)(10) of the Federal
Property and Administrative Services
Act of 1949, As Amended

In accordance with the requirements of the FPR, Part 1-3, I make the following findings:

1. The NRC proposes to procure by negotiation with Alderson Reporting Company an extension of stenographic reporting services provided under Contract No. NRC-17-80-448-02 for the period from August 7, 1982 through November 15, 1982. The estimated cost of the proposed procurement is \$80,000.00.
2. The award of a follow-on contract has been hindered by delays encountered in the preparation and issuance of a viable Request for Proposal (RFP). Procurement by negotiation of the above described services is necessary to prevent the interruption of essential services during the solicitation and negotiation of the requirement prior to award of a successor contract.
3. Use of formal advertising for procurement of the above-described services is impracticable since it would be a duplication of competitive procurement procedures now in progress.

Determination

Based on the foregoing findings, I hereby determine, within the meaning of Section 302(c)(10) of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, that the proposed contract is for services for which it is impracticable to obtain competition by formal advertising.
