NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENTS TO
FACILITY OPERATING LICENSES

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has received a request from Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo, the licensee) to withdraw CECo's application for proposed amendments to Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-72, NPF-77, NPF-37 and NPF-66, issued to the licensee for operation of Braidwood Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2, and Byron Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2, respectively, located in Will County and Ogle County, Illinois, respectively. Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License and Opportunity for Hearing was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on June 28, 1989 (54 FR 27223).

The proposed amendment would change the Technical Specifications to incorporate revised ventilation flowrates, revise heater dissipation rates, clarify a testing method, correct a typographical error and delete a footnote reference.


By letter dated December 5, 1990, the licensee withdrew the application for the proposed amendments. The Commission has considered the licensee's request and has determined that permission to withdraw the March 6, 1989, application for amendments should be granted.
