In accordance with 10 CFR Part 50.59, we are enclosing 40 copies of a requested amendment to the operating licenses DPR-77 and DPR-79 for a change to the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant units 1 and 2 technical specifications (enclosure 1). The proposed change requests relief in the surveillance requirement, 4.8.1.1.2.d.11, alternating current sources for electrical power systems. Enclosure 2 provides the justification for the proposed changes.

In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 170.22, we have determined the proposed amendment to be Class III for unit 1 and Class I for unit 2. These classifications are based on the facts that the changes involve a single safety issue and that the changes apply to two identical units on the same site. The remittance fee of \$4400 is being wired to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Attention: Licensing Fee Management Branch.
