FOIA Request:

Dear FOI Officer:

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, I request access to and copies of the United States Geological Survey's independent analysis and review of Pacific Gas & Electric's Long Term Seismic Program. This review was authorized by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as part of the LTSP and was forwarded to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in draft form in the fall of 1990. I am seeking the draft version.

I agree to pay reasonable duplication fees for the processing of this request in an amount not to exceed \$ 100.00. However, please notify me prior to your incurring any expenses in excess of that amount. In addition, I am requesting the waiver of all fees other than duplicating as the release of this document will contribute significantly to the public's knowledge concerning the seismic safety of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.


If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold this information or to deny a waiver of fees.

I am making this request on behalf of citizens who have been waiting over two years for the release of a final report on the Long Term Seismic Program and this draft is an integral part of this review. As this information is of

utmost importance to the citizens of San Luis Obispo and Santa Barbara counties who will be impacted grievously by any release of radiation at the plant caused by an earthquake, I would appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request. I look forward to your replay within 10 business days, as the statute requires.

Thank you for your assistance on this matter.
