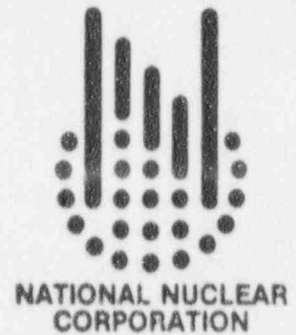

This license request is for one scanner with a set of spare parts, and any spare parts in the future for the anticipated life of the scanner which is approximately ten years. The documentation typically includes drawings and vendor manuals that would be required for the customers to maintain their equipment.

This passive scanner includes a gadolinium detector made by Siemens in Germany. We are now in the process of applying to the DOC for an International Import Certificate. Our plan is to import the detector and add it to our passive scanner. When we ship the scanner, the gadolinium detector will be included in the shipment.

We would like to include the sources listed in this license application because we have some concern that the regulations granting a general license for source byproducts may change before we ship the scanner.
