Gentlemen:

The Commission's Memorandum and Order, April 7, 1994, CLI-94-05, paragraph VII(6), requires the Staff to make available to the parties for inspection and copying the referenced OI report, at the time a decision with respect to enforcement has been made. On May 9, 1994, the Staff issued a Notice of Violation regarding the matter of reporting with respect to diesel generators following the March 20, 1990, site incident. Accordingly, the staff, in order to expedite this proceeding, is providing herewith a copy of the OI Report (Case No. 2-90-020R) to the parties.

The Staff formed the Vogtle Coordinating Group to evaluate the OI Report. That Group's evaluation was completed on February 9, 1994, memorandum from David B. Matthews to Thomas E. Murley, Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. A copy of that analysis is also being provided to the parties.

The above documents were the subject of an earlier notification to the Board (BN Nos. 94-01 and 94-03) dated January 3, 1994, and February 22, 1994, respectively.

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


