

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on February 27, 1991, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C, (1991) (Enforcement Policy) the following violations was identified:

Condition 17 of License No. 13-26104-01 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in an application dated February 19, 1986. The referenced application requires, in part, that the Radiation Safety Committee meet quarterly.

Condition 19 of License No. 13-07964-08 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in an application dated December 24, 1989. The referenced application requires, in part, that the Radiation Safety Committee meet quarterly.


Contrary to the above, the Radiation Safety Committee failed to meet during the third quarter of 1988 and the first and third quarters of 1990.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the corrective steps that have been taken and the results achieved; (2) the corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
