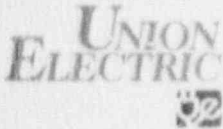

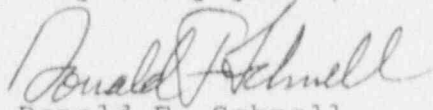

UPDATE ON NRC UNFETTERED ACCESS TO CALLAWAY PLANT

REFERENCE: Union Electric Company letter to NRC
dated August 31, 1988 (ULNRC-1824)

This letter is to inform you of upcoming changes to the NRC Unfettered Access Program at Callaway Plant. Effective April 15, 1991, Union Electric will no longer require NRC employees and contractors who satisfy NRC General Employee Training (GET) requirements to receive training in Hazardous Communications. Individuals will be provided with site specific information, either at the NRC Region III office or upon arrival at Callaway Plant, describing our Security, Emergency Response, Industrial Safety, and Radiation Worker programs. The training requirements for unfettered access will be satisfied by reviewing applicable site specific information for the above programs.

This revision to our Unfettered Access Program should help in expediting unfettered access to Callaway Plant. If you should have any questions concerning this change, please contact M. S. Evans at (314)676-8258.
