

NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO GOVERNOR CUOMO'S MOTION  
TO FILE A BRIEF OPPOSING PETITIONERS' JOINT STAY MOTION

On March 22, 1991, Robert Abrams, New York's Attorney General, on behalf of Governor Mario Cuomo, filed a motion asking that Governor Cuomo be allowed to file the amicus brief accompanying the motion, opposing the March 8, 1991 stay request filed by Scientists and Engineers For Secure Energy, Inc. and Shoreham-Wading River Central School District ("Petitioners") in the above-captioned proceedings. The other parties in these proceedings filed responses to Petitioners' joint stay request on March 25, 1991.

The Staff notes that by Order dated November 15, 1990 (unpublished), the Commission allowed Governor Cuomo to file an amicus brief opposing Petitioners' motion for reconsideration of CLI-90-8. The Staff has no objection to Governor Cuomo's March 22, 1991 motion.

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
