
Thank you for your response of February 14, 1991, to our Notice of Violation issued on January 17, 1991, concerning activities conducted at your Vogtle facility. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201.

After reviewing your reply to the Notice of Violation, we do not agree with your request to reclassify the severity level to a Severity Level V for the reason stated below.

Although you identified the continuing problems with the control room drawings, and had virtually rectified all the drawing legibility problems, the NRC maintains that the corrective actions committed to in your letter dated January 23, 1990, were not fully implemented. Had you continued your monthly audits which were implemented to avoid further violations and which you committed to continue until full compliance was achieved, these additional problems could have been recognized sooner and corrected. The NRC recognizes that the additional drawing problems were not as significant as the legibility issues identified previously. However, continuing control room drawing problems have been identified by your staff, including wrong revisions, missing As Built Notices, and drawings which were superseded but still on file. The NRC views these discrepancies as more than of minor safety significance, and does not consider your corrective actions sufficient to reclassify this violation.

Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.
