Arkansas Nuclear One - Units 1 & 2 Docket Nos. 50-313 and 50-368 License Nos. DPR-51 and NPF-6 Modification to Amendment 6 to the ANO Emergency Plan

Gentlemen:

In response to your letter dated December 23, 1982, (ØCNA128225) requesting further clarification of Amendment 6 to the ANO Emergency Plan, the following is provided.

Upon declaration of an Emergency Action Level (EAL) at ANO, the immediate notification/communication responsibility, as specified in Figure 10 of the ANO Emergency Plan, is carried out by the Shift Administrative Assistant (SAA) of the affected unit. The SAA from the unaffected unit is available within 30 minutes to provide further support in this area. Attachment 8 to ANO Emergency Plan Implementing Procedure 1903.10, "Emergency Action Level Response," lists additional "Control Room/Technical Support Center Communications Personnel," who are available within 60 minutes to assist in notification/communication. The ANO Emergency Plan Figure 10 will be amended to identify the responsible positions/titles for carrying out the notification/communication function. This amendment will be implemented by June 30, 1983. Training for the individuals serving the notification/communication function will be carried out as part of the 1983 Emergency Preparedness Training Program. The training of the notification/communication personnel will be accomplished prior to March 15, 1983.
