- Describe in detail how the material required by Enclosure 2 of the March 28, 1980 letter from Harold R. Denton to all power reactor applicants and licensees concerning qualifications of reactor operators is incorporated into the Phase I and II sections of your Criteria for Reactor Operator Training and Licensing.
- 2. As above for Enclosure 3 to Denton's letter of March 28, 1980.
- Describe the program that has been provided to assure that instructors are cognizant of current operating history, problems, and changes to procedures and administrative limitations.
- 4. If subcontractors (i.e., General Physics, NUS, etc.) are used to supplement your training staff, what actions have you taken to assure that they meet the requirements of A.2.d, A.2.e, C.2, and C.3 of Enclosure 1 to Denton's letter of March 28, 1980.
- 5. Item II.B.4 of NUREG-0737 requires that managers and technicians in the Instrumentation and Control, health physics and chemistry departments shall receive training commensurate with their responsibility in mitigating core damage.
