This letter completes the NRC staff response to Mr. Tyrone C. Fahner's petition of March 24, 1982 (Petition) and Amendment dated May 3, 1982, on behalf of the State of Illinois. The Petition and the Amendment have been considered under 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations. My Director's Decision under 10 CFR 2.206 of July 19, 1982 (DD-82-9) denied the State of Illinois' Petition and Amendment with respect to allegations pertaining to La Salle County Station, Unit 1 which required satisfactory resolution in order to proceed with licensing. For the reasons stated in the Director's Decision enclosed with this letter, the remaining parts of the Petition and Amendment which pertain to allegations related to La Salle County Station, Unit 2 have been denied.

A copy of this decision will be filed with the Secretary for the Commission's review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c). As provided in 10 CFR 2.206(c), this decision will become the final action of the Commission in 25 days, unless the Commission determines to review the decision within that time.
