Chairman Carr's comments on SECY 91-022:

I approve the staff's course of action for the Task Force on Pilgrim Offsite Emergency Preparedness subject to the following comments:

- I agree with Commissioner Curtiss' comment regarding coordination with the Federal Emergency Management Agency;
- Prior to holding a public meeting to solicit comments on the draft Task Force report, the staff should discuss the preliminary findings in the draft report with the public officials responsible for offsite emergency planning;
- In light of the Inspector General's earlier criticism that the Lessons Learned Task Force did not address the full scope of the issues in its mandate, the current Task Force should clearly address, in format and content, the tasks assigned in its charter, and should fully describe the facts and other considerations underlying its findings and recommendations;
- The Task Force should document in detail the process and procedures employed in this review so that they may be used in any future activity of this type.

In view of the General Counsel's memorandum of February 22, 1991, on NRC's role in emergency planning matters, I believe the authority to undertake the Task Force effort is clear and the Office of Inspector General's comments in its February 6, 1991 memorandum have been addressed adequately
