NRC/FEMA JOINT QUARTERLY REPORT
TO CONGRESS ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
October 1, 1982 to December 31, 1982

This is the fourteenth joint status report to Congress on emergency preparedness and is the second quarterly report since the reporting frequency was changed from monthly to quarterly. The report is in response to the direction given in the June 8, 1981, letter from the Nuclear Regulation Subcommittee and provides the status of each agency's radiological emergency planning review activities for nuclear power plants. *

The report is organized in two parts. Part I was prepared by the NRC. Tables 1 and 2 of Part I provide the status of offsite and onsite emergency planning for applicants for an operating license. Table 3, Part I, of the report describes the NRC staffing levels assigned to the emergency preparedness program. Part II of the report was prepared by FEMA and presents a summary of pertinent offsite plans and principal milestones.

Decision and Hearing Dates are consistent with those reported to the House * Committee on Appropriations, Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development.

On August 2, 1982 FEMA in a letter to the NRC staff identified deficiencies in emergency preparedness at Indian Point, Units 2 and 3. The NRC staff in a letter dated August 3, 1982 notified the licensees for the Indian Point units that, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(s)(2)(ii), it was initiating a "120-day clock"; at the end of this period, if the deficiencies were not cured, the Commission would decide whether to take enforcement action. FEMA provided the Commission with a status report on offsite emergency planning at Indian Point on December 17, 1982. In a decision issued on December 23, 1982, the Commission decided that no shutdown or other enforcement action was needed at that time. The status of emergency preparedness will be revisited by the Commission upon receipt of FEMA's evaluation of the exercise, scheduled for March, 1983.

PART I

Background - Operating Reactors

The emergency preparedness rule that became effective November 3, 1980, required licensees to submit upgraded emergency plans by January 2, 1981; to submit emergency procedures to activate the plans by March 1, 1981; to have the emergency plans and procedures implemented by April 1, 1981; and to demonstrate that administrative and physical means have been established for alerting and providing prompt instructions to the public within the 10-mile plume exposure pathway emergency planning zone (EPZ) by July 1, 1981. (The Commission subsequently revised the July 1, 1981 date to February 1, 1982.) In addition, the emergency preparedness rule required the licensees, working with State and local governments, to implement an upgraded and integrated emergency plan for the ingestion pathway EPZ out to the 50-mile radius around each operating nuclear power plant. Guidance for meeting the upgraded emergency preparedness requirements is provided in NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, "Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants."

The NRC and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) developed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) dated November 4, 1980, that describes each agency's responsibility for radiological emergency preparedness at and around nuclear power plants. According to the MOU, NRC and FEMA determine the adequacy of emergency preparedness by licensees and State and local governments, respectively. To make the respective determinations, NRC reviews licensee emergency plans, FEMA reviews the emergency plans of offsite authorities, and both observe and evaluate joint exercises conducted by licensees and by State and local government organizations. In addition, NRC performs onsite appraisals to evaluate the adequacy of licensee's emergency preparedness programs. The NRC reviews the FEMA findings and determinations to ascertain the overall state of emergency preparedness.

The schedule projected for NRC to complete the review of the licensee plans * and the onsite appraisals for all operating power reactors was April 1, 1982. The onsite appraisals for all operating reactors have been completed and all appraisal reports have been issued. A joint exercise was also observed at all licensed sites by NRC and FEMA. These joint exercises were held to meet the requirement in the emergency preparedness rule that, effective April 1, 1981, all operating reactors conduct annual exercises of their emergency plans. In addition, many followup inspections have been conducted and one half of the second round of exercises are completed.

Background - Reactors Under Construction

The NRC rule (10 CFR 50.47 (a)) for emergency preparedness specified that NRC will issue no operating license (OL) until there is reasonable assurance that adequate measures can and will be taken to protect the public in the event of an emergency. (The rule was subsequently amended to permit operation up to 5% of rated power without an NRC or FEMA finding on the adequacy of offsite preparedness.) This reasonable assurance must include the preparedness capabilities of both the licensees and State and local organizations.

In a memorandum of understanding with NRC, FEMA agreed to make findings and determinations on the adequacy of State and local emergency plans. FEMA also agreed to provide expert witnesses in NRC's licensing process. NRC agreed to review FEMA findings and determinations, and to make decisions on the overall state of emergency preparedness (i.e., integration of emergency preparedness onsite as determined by the NRC and offsite as determined by FEMA and reviewed by NRC) before issuing operating licenses.

Recently, the potential delays have been significantly reduced due to the capability of the Licensing Boards to address the emergency preparedness issues later in the hearing process. However, there is concern that findings on offsite preparedness issues may not be available on a schedule that is compatible with the NRC licensing schedule. There is also concern that inadequate State and local plans, over which licensees have no direct control, could delay the issuance of operating licenses. In some cases, action by State legislatures has been necessary before the licensee, State, and local plans could be legally implemented in the State affected. Similar actions are pending in a few other cases. FEMA concurs with these statements and the schedules given in Table 1.

- ¹ The FEMA Findings provided on the estimated dates indicated are generally based on a determination of the adequacy of plans. Licenses will be appropriately conditioned in those cases where FEMA has not approved the offsite preparedness for a particular site. Dates in parentheses are for supplemental information to FEMA Findings previously provided.
- ² Generally 5 months prior to a hearing except in those cases where hearings are scheduled in the near term and based on discussions with the ASLB Panel. Dates in parentheses are for supplemental FEMA Findings. In cases where there is no hearing, the dates are based on 3 months prior to Commission Decision date.
- ³ The delay is determined as the difference between FEMA FINDING NEEDED and ESTIMATED FEMA FINDING and is in addition to any delays estimated in the report to the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development.
- ⁴ In hearings where emergency preparedness is contested, testimony from FEMA is needed approximately 45 days prior to Start of Hearing.
- ⁵ Dates shown are for full power; however, initial licensing may proceed (restricting power to 5% of full power) based on a favorable ASLB decision (if applicable). Dates are consistent with those reported to the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development. *
- ⁶ For Shoreham, the hearings on offsite emergency preparedness issues are currently scheduled to begin in June 1983, at the earliest. It is likely that an initial decision on all licensing matters may not be available until October 1983. Recent information (after the cutoff date of this report) indicates there will be a potential three month delay. *
- ⁷ An operating license for Grand Gulf restricting operation to fuel loading and operation up to 5% power was issued. A Commission decision regarding operation above 5% power will be made on a schedule commensurate with the applicant's need for full power authorization. *
- ⁸ The Licensing Board issued an Initial Decision June 21, 1982. It resolved most contentions favorably to Applicants and imposed five conditions with respect to offsite emergency planning. However, because the Board could not identify a clear course of corrective action, it declined to authorize full power operation of the Zimmer Station until the problems relating to the evacuation of Clermont County, Ohio and Campbell County, Kentucky, plume exposure EPZ, and schools have been resolved. *

In August the Board authorized the Staff to issue a low power license for Zimmer (limited to 5% of rated power) but denied applicants' requested relief with respect to deficiencies in offsite emergency preparedness found in the Board's Initial Decision. Should applicants decide to demonstrate to the Board that the deficiencies have been resolved, further proceedings will be required. The Board is prepared to proceed expeditiously to resolve the outstanding emergency preparedness issues on advice from applicants that they are ripe for consideration.

Because of the Commission decision halting all safety related construction at Zimmer and the uncertainties, no potential offsite emergency planning delay is presently indicated.

¹⁰The estimated FEMA finding date for Zimmer is based on the expected dates for * the development and review of the emergency plans and procedures (including school evacuation plans) for Kentucky and Ohio.

¹¹For Shoreham, the Suffolk County emergency plan has been submitted to the * County legislature for review and approval. After approval, the plan will be submitted to the State of New York for incorporation into the State site-specific plan. FEMA will then review the plan and furnish their findings to the NRC.

¹²For Callaway, hearings on emergency preparedness issues are expected to * commence in May 1983.

¹³The start of hearing date for Byron was established by the Board pursuant to stipulation by the parties. The Board does not presently anticipate any delay attributable to offsite emergency planning issues.

¹⁴Hearing for Perry is scheduled to begin February 1983 with emergency planning * issues to be heard some time later as required plans become available. A Commission decision of October 1983, as scheduled, is feasible. A potential 3-month delay for issuance of a full-power license exists if current construction schedule holds. Delay is due to problems associated with the development of final, approved County plans for the three counties within the plume exposure pathway EPZ. NRC and FEMA staffs continue to work toward a resolution.

¹⁵No delay for Seabrook is expected from emergency planning issues, based on information from the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel.

FORMAL SUBMISSION refers to the date of the official submission by the governor, or his designated representative, as defined in 44 CFR 350.7 (proposed). Preliminary drafts may already have been provided for review on an informal basis.

JOINT EXERCISE refers to the date of an exercise, as defined in 44 CFR 350.9 (proposed), in which both the utility and the governments participate and in which most of the major elements in the plan are exercised. Where this date is at least a year later than the date of the formal submission and/or public meeting date, it is the date of the second annual exercise of the plans.

PUBLIC MEETING refers to the date of a pre-announced meeting held in the vicinity of the plant, as discussed in CFR 350.10. The meeting is designed to inform the populace about the plans for emergency response and is normally conducted by the State.

READY FOR HEADQUARTERS is the date on which the FEMA Regional Director completes his evaluation (see 44 CFR 350.11) of State and local plans and preparedness around the site and forwards it to FEMA Headquarters for review.

NRC REQUESTED DATE is the date by which the NRC requires from FEMA either a final finding and determination if available, or if not available, an interim status report. These dates are updated in negotiations between NRC and FEMA.

INTERIM FINDING is the date on which FEMA has or intends to provide a partial report to NRC.

(a) In the case of off-site plans relating to a plant licensed to operate, the status will be reported primarily on the results of a joint exercise.

(b) In the case of off-site plans relating to a plant not yet licensed to operate, the finding will be limited to the RAC review of the latest State and local off-site plans or a status report where plans are not available.

FINAL FINDING is the date on which FEMA has provided or intends to provide a formal finding and determination in accordance with 44 CFR 350.12 (proposed). Lack of either a final or interim finding date for a State plan followed by a '#' will not delay a FEMA formal finding. The '#' indicates that the only planning elements required are those related to the ingestion pathway. While this will be discussed in the final finding, it would not preclude FEMA from making a final finding.

HEARING DATE and LICENSE DATE reflect current information being furnished by NRC in their monthly report to Representative Tom Bevill, Chairman, House Appropriations Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development.

The first column in Table I on pages 19 through 28 lists the date of formal submission of offsite emergency preparedness plans in support of plants licensed to operate.

Dates in the future have been projected based upon information provided by the FEMA Regions as a result of their intimate knowledge of the State and local situation. Plans for all facilities licensed to operate have been received informally at least in draft and have been reviewed by a FEMA Regional Assistance Committee. At least one joint exercise had been completed by March 31, 1982, for all licensed sites, except for three sites. An exercise has now been held at each of these three sites as follows: Peach Bottom on June 16, 1982; at Rancho Seco on June 23, 1982; and at Fitzpatrick on August 11, 1982.

Sites involved this month are Byron, Perry, Shoreham and Zimmer.

BYRON (IL)

Plans are required for the two counties of Ogle, and Winnebago in addition to the State of Illinois site-specific plan. The State's practice has been to do the site-specific planning in conjunction with the political subdivisions. State involvement in the planning and subsequent drills and training has taken about five months for each of the sites.

The State of Illinois has submitted to Region V the State General Plan, Volume I of the Illinois Plan for Radiological Accidents. This document is the plan from which all site-specific plans are developed to integrate local offsite planning. The State agencies involved in radiological emergency preparedness are the Illinois Emergency Services and Disaster Agency (ESDA) and the Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety (DNS). Because of the significant number of operating and potential operational nuclear power plants in the State, Illinois has devised an organized approach to the development of radiological emergency plans which is: five months prior to the approval date for a joint onsite/offsite exercise, the State assigns a team of radiological emergency planners to a temporary duty station within the 10-mile EPZ to develop, in coordination with local government officials, the radiological emergency plans site-specific to the licensee's nuclear power station. While plan development proceeds, a total impact training program is implemented. The Illinois ESDA and DNS provide indepth training for local officials and emergency responders. Prior to the exercise, training is completed and the newly developed plan is provided to FEMA Region V and the RAC.

The Illinois State Planners, seven full-time persons, have been dedicating their efforts to completion of the Byron NPP plans since September 27, 1982. A draft was completed in early December and has been provided to the utility for their comments. No further distribution has been made. It will not be submitted to FEMA R-V until the second draft is complete.

Based on the above, the State of Illinois has indicated that the Byron site-specific plans for the two counties will not be furnished to FEMA Region V before April, 1983. The plans will then be reviewed by Region V and an interim finding furnished to NRC.

PERRY (OH)

Radiological emergency preparedness plans are required for the three counties of Ashtabula, Lake and Geauga in addition to the State of Ohio site specific plan. PRC Vorhees and Associates, an engineering consulting firm, has been retained by the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company to develop the county plans. The State of Ohio has received a second draft of the Ashtabula County plan from PRC Vorhees and Associates for review. Initial planning meetings have been conducted in Lake and Geauga Counties. State of Ohio sources have indicated that the Geauga County Disaster Services Coordinator has resigned and this has impacted the planning effort in Geauga County. Lake County has rejected the draft plan prepared by PRC Vorhees for that county and this has impeded the planning effort there. Ohio has exerted pressure on Lake and Geauga Counties to complete their planning efforts. However, there has been some local resistance.

SHOREHAM (NY)

Plans are required for the County of Suffolk in addition to the State of New York site-specific plan. Development of plans for Shoreham has had a lower priority than the development of plans for other sites in the State of New York.

By letter dated March 1st, 1982, the Director of Emergency Preparedness for Suffolk County requested that no exercise be held until all warning sirens are completely installed and tested. The utility arranged for a contractor to draft local plans. These were unacceptable to the county of Suffolk.

A joint meeting including representatives from FEMA, NRC, New York State, Suffolk County, and the Utility was held May 14, 1982. The discussion centered on the status of developing an acceptable Radiological Emergency Plan for Suffolk County. The attorney representing Suffolk County stated that they were in the process of having a contractor develop their plans and anticipated their completion by October 1982.

The plans for Suffolk County have been completed. On December 2, 1982, the Suffolk County Executive presented the County plan to the County Legislature for their review and approval. As yet, they have not voted on the plan.

The New York State Supreme Court has ruled that Suffolk County is to have a plan submitted to the State of New York by February 22, 1983. If this date is not met, the State of New York is free to submit an earlier plan prepared by the Long Island Lighting Company or that prepared by Suffolk County.

Based on the above, the Shoreham site-specific plans will be furnished to FEMA Region II around March 15, 1983. The plans will then be reviewed and an interim finding provided to the NRC on July 15, 1983.

ZIMMER (OH)

Plans are required for Clermont County in Ohio, the State of Ohio site-specific plan, the three counties of Bracken, Campbell, and Pendleton in Kentucky and the State of Kentucky site-specific plan.

The State of Ohio submitted their draft plans to FEMA Region V on September 14, 1981. The Region V Regional Assistance Committee (RAC) forwarded its review of the plans to Ohio on October 15, 1981. The Region V staff review indicated that the draft Ohio State and local plans offered reasonable assurance that the planning basis for Zimmer is adequate and that the public in the Ohio portions of the plume emergency planning zone can be reasonably protected if the planning is properly implemented. There were deficiencies in the text of the plans, but the Regional staff reported that these cannot be reasonably construed as faults in the actual radiological emergency preparedness of State and local governments. These deficiencies are currently the subject of corrective actions on the part of offsite authorities.

The State of Kentucky submitted their draft plans to FEMA Region IV on September 15, 1981. The Region IV RAC forwarded its review of the plans to Kentucky on October 28, 1981. The Region IV RAC review of the draft Kentucky State and local plans did not reveal any major deficiency. The Region stated that the plans were reasonably adequate and there was reasonable assurance that the public in the Kentucky portions of the Zimmer emergency planning zone can be adequately protected if the plans are properly implemented.

NRC was furnished the above information by memorandum dated October 23, 1981, as an initial interim finding of offsite preparedness in support of the William H. Zimmer Nuclear Power Station. A supplemental finding, including a detailed A through P evaluation of the adequacy of offsite emergency preparedness was furnished to NRC on January 22, 1982.

A joint exercise for the Zimmer Nuclear Station was conducted on November 18, 1981. A copy of the exercise evaluation was furnished to NRC on May 26, 1982.

Atomic Safety and Licensing Board hearings were held starting January 25, 1982. Many of the key emergency response standard operating procedures necessary to fully implement the plans were not developed and in place at the time of the November exercise. By request from NRC on March 23, 1982, FEMA agreed on April 22, 1982, to conduct a field verification of the completion schedules. However, NRC Division of Emergency Preparedness has been advised that there would be a several month delay. The preparatory groundwork for this effort should be completed by early Spring of 1983. A status report was furnished to NRC on November 9, 1982.

Regional Assistance Committee participation by other Federal agency representatives, which had improved significantly in plan review and exercise observation during the last part of fiscal year 1981, varied during FY 82 and was lessened by staff reductions and budget limitations in some Federal agencies. In particular, HHS staff participation decreased drastically during FY 82 and FY 83. Also, DOC participation has been limited in FY 83.

INSTANCES OF STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT RELUCTANCE TO SUBMIT PLANS

FEMA has no formal documented record of a refusal by a State to submit plans. Previously we reported that six towns in New Hampshire in the Seabrook emergency planning zone had formally stated in writing to the State of New Hampshire that there was no way to safely evacuate the emergency planning zone, and that no town money would be spent on developing plans. Towns were Rye, Kensington, Hampton, Hampton Falls, Seabrook, and South Hampton.

The State, after passing enabling legislation, awarded a contract for the development of the State and local plans by a consultant. However, seven municipalities in the Seabrook 10 mile EPZ, Hampton, Hampton Falls, Rye, Kensington, S. Hampton, Exeter and Stratham, have refused to participate in the development of their plans. They contested through court action the legality of the State to contract the development of local plans. In December, 1982, a court decision has affirmed the legality of the contract. As of the end of December, 1982, there has been little progress in the development of plans for these seven municipalities. Draft plans are scheduled for submission in January 1983, and will not contain plans for the above listed seven municipalities.

(Response to question No. 7)

On April 2, 1981, the St. Lucie Board of County Commissioners resolution #81-37 requested NRC & FEMA to require Florida Power & Light to pay costs of a bridge, sirens, a central communications center in a protected facility, a fire station on the Florida Power & Light property, and tests of the emergency plan. To date, the County Commissioners position remains unchanged.

The State of Oregon has legislation which requires Portland General Electric to finance offsite preparedness.

The State of Washington has negotiated agreements/contracts to finance offsite preparedness with both commercial utilities operating in the State, namely the Washington Public Power Supply System and the Puget Sound Power and Light Co. mant. Cowlitz County has negotiated a separate agreement/contract with the Portland General Electric Company. Benton and Franklin Counties have an arrangement for financing various preparedness programs with the Washington Public Power Supply System. Progress in the development of offsite plans would not have occurred if these agreements were not in place and continuing.

The State of Massachusetts, through its contractor, prepared a local plan for the Town of Monroe and forwarded a copy to FEMA Region I. This plan has not been signed, nor approved, by the Town of Monroe officials. The Town of Monroe, with a population of 216, is 3/4 of a mile west of the Yankee Atomic Plant at Rowe, Massachusetts. The Board of Selectmen consider their road network inadequate for evacuation and refused to approve the plans prepared by the State. The Town, by letter to FEMA dated June 10, 1981, requested FEMA to instruct Yankee, via the NRC, to provide them with funds to rebuild the roads. The Massachusetts Civil Defense Agency inspected the area July 8, 1981, and, by letter dated July 22, 1981, advised the Town of Monroe that they found the routes adequate. The impasse continued since by letter dated August 17, 1981, the Town of Monroe documented their disagreement with the State position. However, they did participate in the exercise held March 25, 1982, and are expected to follow this plan if an incident should occur.

The California State legislature passed a bill on August 31, 1982, which will require the utilities to provide funding for REP planning over the next five years. The bill provides \$300,000 each year for the State level, and \$100,000 each year per reactor unit for planning at the local level. The bill has been signed by the Governor and will take effect on January 1, 1983.

The State of California Office of Emergency Services has guaranteed the three counties impacting the Rancho Seco site funding from the State to cover the first few months of the year. The counties of Sacramento and San Joaquin have agreed to proceed based on this guarantee. However, the county of Amador has ceased work on offsite planning as of January 1, 1983, until such time as the utility provides a guarantee of previously promised additional funding. The utility will present the funding request to their Board for approval in February or March.

There have been instances of local governments making their plans contingent on financial expenditures by the utility for the Callaway Nuclear Power Station in Missouri. The localities involved are: Callaway, Gasconade, Osage, and Montgomery. All have indicated their requirement for funding of equipment and personnel to Union Electric, prior to their approval of local plans developed by a contractor, according to press reports.

The utility has offered numerous funding proposals to all counties within the 10-mile EPZ. To date, no local government has signed off on plans. The negotiations between the counties and the utility are reportedly continuing on the funding issue. It appears, however, that an impasse in securing the cooperation of at least one of the counties (Montgomery) is a possibility.
