Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1
Post-TMI Requirements; Action Plan Item II.K.3.18

The Enclosure to Reference (1) forwarded a recommended schedule for completion of NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.18, "Modification of Automatic Depressurization System Logic". In Reference (2) Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) responded by informing the Staff that it was pursuing resolution of this item through the BWR Owner's Group with submission of a revised position planned for September 30, 1982. Reference (3) revised the schedule for the BWR Owners' Group submittal, which was forwarded via Reference (4).

NNECO has reviewed this revised BWR Owners' Group study and found it applicable to Millstone Unit No. 1. NNECO has prepared and will implement Emergency Procedure Guidelines based on General Electric Topical Report NEDO-24934, "Emergency Procedure Guidelines, Revision 2" at Millstone Unit No. 1; NNECO is formulating an implementation schedule based on the considerations identified in Reference (5) and concludes that no further action is required to resolve NUREG-0737 Item II.K.3.18.
