They are heated with public address hook-ups, are accessible to the handicapped and elderly, and have adequate seating and table capacity. These premises will be donated as a public service by the Temple but a donation will be greatly appreciated to offset expenses incurred by the Temple for heat, electricity and the like.

WHEREFORE, PARENTS respectfully requests that the Board direct that PARENTS be able to present its witnesses at hearings held at Temple Israel of Northern Westchester.
