

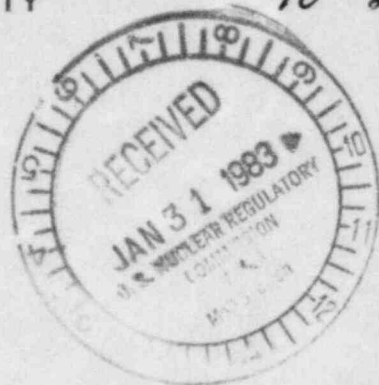

TVA hereby requests an amendment to its special nuclear material license, SNM-1861, dated September 5, 1979 for Watts Bar Nuclear Plant unit 1 and SNM-1873, dated February 17, 1981 for unit 2. Our applications were dated June 8, 1979 for unit 1 and May 13, 1980 for unit 2 and the supplements thereto.

We request item C on page 9 of each application be deleted. The purpose of this amendment is to delete references to two fire truck pumpers as part of the plant's fire protection system. These fire trucks were included in the SNM licenses early in the construction stage before completion and demonstration of a reliable "in-house" fire protection system. At this time, however, the system described in the FSAR, section 9.5.1, Fire Protection System, is operational and the need for the additional protection of these fire trucks no longer exists.
