SUBJECT: WOLF CREEK - DAILY HIGHLIGHT

Wolf Creek

On February 18, 1983, Region IV personnel held an enforcement meeting with representatives of Kansas Gas & Electric Company (KG&E) and Daniel International Corporation (DIC) to discuss significant 50.55(e) concerns. The concerns resulted from an indepth review of the turnover of the Borated Refueling Water Storage Tank (BNO1) System from construction to pre-op testing personnel. An evaluation performed by the KG&E Surveillance Audit Organization found problems with the BNO1 system after QC had signed-off on it. This, coupled with a second Audit Organization finding that component testing was a non-conforming program prompted the region to hold the meeting.

As a result of the enforcement meeting, KG&E issued a self-imposed stop work order on the turnover of systems from construction to pre-op testing personnel and on component testing of safety-related systems which KG&E can take credit for during pre-op testing. The order was effective Tuesday, February 22, 1983. In addition, KG&E has issued a news release on the stop-work order. Region IV is preparing a preliminary notification for the Commission which describes the recent developments.

If there are any changes in the current status or if any additional problems arise I will keep you informed.
