SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE WITH SCE, MARCH 10, 1982

I am concerned about a statement made in Paragraph No. 2 of your memo to J. Lieberman, Director, Enforcement and Investigation, IE, dated March 17. The statement "the licensee was provided an advance copy of the details of the inspection report to better prepare himself for the March 10, 1982 Enforcement Conference" gives the impression that we gave a draft of the report to the licensee and that the draft would be discussed at the meeting before becoming finalized. In view of that appearance, please answer the following:

1. Was the "advance copy" an unsigned draft of the inspection report? - or was it a signed copy of the final report which had not yet undergone proprietary review?
2. Were any changes made to the report following the meeting?

Obviously, my concern relates to any possible appearance of "negotiating" with a licensee the contents of any inspection report. Your reply should provide me with assurance that this was not the case in the subject instance. By copy of this memo I am asking Al Johnson to draft a memo from me to supervisory staff establishing clear guidance on the handling of draft inspection and investigation reports.
