MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Re West Branch Conservation Association's Motion to
Reinstate That Part of Contention 3.2
Regarding Utility Workers)

MEMORANDUM

By Memorandum and Order of February 7, 1983, this Board re-formulated Contention 3.2, which addressed human responses during an emergency. The reformulation deleted explicit reference to the response of utility employees. On February 19, 1983, West Branch Conservation Association (WBCA) filed a motion seeking reinstatement of the reference to utility employees in the reformulated contention.

The deletion of the mention of public utility employees in reformulated Contention 3.2 was not meant to exclude consideration of the response of those employees during an emergency. We believe

this issue is relevant to and included in the scope of the re-formulated contention.


We note, however, that our Memorandum and Order of February 7, 1983 inadvertently omitted WBCA as a contributing intervenor, and we hereby amend that Memorandum and Order to correct that omission.

1. That our Memorandum and Order of February 7, 1983 is amended to include the West Branch Conservation Association as a contributing intervenor on reformulated Contention 3.2.
