Gentlemen:

IE Bulletin 83-01, "Failure of Reactor Trip Breakers (Westinghouse DB-50) to open on Automatic Trip Signal," transmitted February 25, 1983 (ØCNAØ28324), was received by our office March 2, 1983.

Westinghouse DB-50 breakers are not used as reactor trip breakers at Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO) Unit 1 or Unit 2. General Electric AK-2A-25 breakers are used for reactor trip on ANO Unit 1. ANO Unit 2 uses General Electric AK-2-25 reactor trip breakers.

Although not specifically required of licensees not using the Westinghouse DB-50 reactor trip breakers, copies of the subject IE Bulletin were provided to both control rooms and listed on shift turnover sheets at ANO.

In summary, operators at ANO were made aware of the IE Bulletin, and neither unit uses Westinghouse DB-50 reactor trip breakers.
