- 4) Establishing radiation and contamination control areas;
- 5) Biological sampling; and
- 6) Plant access and reporting requirements.

Additionally, the local Medical Support Personnel will participate in an annual medical drill with the Emergency Medical Team.

12.2.9 Local Support Agency Training

The local fire departments will be invited to participate in an annual training session which familiarizes them in plant layout and fire hazards, basic radiation protection needed for fire fighting, and fire protection system orientation.

Selected members from the local police departments will be invited to participate in an annual review session to ensure that they are familiar with their emergency functions.

12.2.10 State Emergency Response Personnel

Selected state emergency response personnel will be offered, on an annual basis, training in the following areas:

- 1) The emergency classification system;
- 2) The off-site dose projection methodology; and
- 3) The plant protective action criteria and its relationship to plant conditions.
