Dear Mr. Churchill:

As the accompanying order indicates, the Appeal Board has scheduled oral argument on Joint Intervenors' appeal from the Licensing Board's November 3, 1982 partial initial decision in the Waterford proceeding for Tuesday, April 19, 1983, at 9:30 a.m. in New Orleans. On the preceding day, Monday, April 18, the Board would like to visit the Waterford 3 plant. In particular, the Board requests that the visit include the following:

1. Tour of Unit 3, including the control room;

- The Emergency Operating Facility and other emergency technical support facilities including the Emergency Operations Center for one of the parishes in the plume EPZ; and
- 3. The radiological monitoring equipment.

If such a site visit can be erranged, the Board would drive over from New Orleans on Monday morning; it suggests that the tour begin at about 10 a.m. Representatives of all parties in the case shall be afforded the opportunity to accompany the Board on its tour, and the Board asks, through this letter, that they advise you no later than March 28 if they plan to attend.
