Dear Mr. DeYoung:

On January 11, 1983 Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) transmitted to you its response to IE Bulletin 82-04 for Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant Unit Nos. 1 and 2. Due to an administrative oversight, this response was not signed under oath or affirmation as required by the bulletin. Repeated below is the complete text of that letter with the appropriate signature under oath. We trust that this oversight has not resulted in any inconvenience to you or your staff.

In response to USNRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement letter of December 3, 1982, Carolina Power & Light Company hereby notifies you that Bunker Ramo electrical penetration assemblies are not used at the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant. For this reason, IE Bulletin Number 82-04 is not applicable and no further action is required.
